Don't forget the membership fee is for EYM (not one ensemble), so if you are in more than one ensemble it doesn't cost any more.

General Information about rehearsals

- □ Please bring a named music stand, pencil and rubber
- Please arrive 5 to 10 minutes before the scheduled start time of the rehearsal to help set up the chairs and be ready to start playing on time! String players in particular need to allow time to tune their instruments.
- Rehearsals end at 11.50am please be ready to pick up your child promptly and young people will be ready for collection shortly after when everything has been cleared away we do expect everyone to help!
- Saturday Music Centre has a tuck shop during the break (10.30 to 10.50am), and the Herefordshire College of Arts has vending machines, so members may want to bring some change.
- Can we remind everybody that usual Health and Safety rules apply. Please do not run, particularly on the stairs, and keep to the areas of the rehearsal venues that are being used by Encore Youth Music. Please be aware that members of the public use the Town Hall in the evenings and that parents, Hereford Sixth Form College and Herefordshire College of Arts staff and members of the public can often be on site on Saturdays.

First Saturday Music Centre

For the first rehearsal of the season only on **Saturday 16**th **September**, please arrive at 9.15am and assemble in the PAC with your band or ensemble; it will be signposted.

Attendance/Absence

- Members are expected to attend all rehearsals and concerts. However, we do understand that there are times when missing a rehearsal is unavoidable. Please let your conductor know if you are going to miss a rehearsal, or:

- Cellists, Double Bass and Bassoon players **MUST** have reliable spike protection.

EYM Membership/Subscription

- The annual cost of EYM membership is heavily subsidised by the Music Service through our DfE funding and from September 2023 is charged at:
 - £140 for one child
 - £225 for all children living in the same household
- Membership is free for low-income families where the school receives Pupil Premium for a child.
- The Herefordshire Music Fund supports all music activities. Go to the Encore website to see if you qualify for a bursary.
