BIO

Mark De-Lisser is one of the most sought after choral directors and vocal coaches in the UK.

He has worked with some of today's top vocal talent, including Ariana Grande, Jessie J and Beverley Knight, and on some of the UK's most watched TV shows, including BBC's BAFTA nominated Our Dementia Choir with Vicky McClure, Songs of Praise and ITV's award winning The Masked Singer.

Driven to inspire and motivate everybody to succeed, Mark helps to increase confidence and selfawareness, whilst improving technique and delivery. Anybody who is fortunate to work with Mark is left feeling uplifted and invigorated.

Mark is perhaps best known for his arrangement of Stand by Me, performed by the Kingdom Choir at the Royal Wedding of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle in 2018, which has now been streamed more than 4 million times on Spotify and has over 10 million views on YouTube.

Since 2019, Mark has been the Live Show Producer for The Virtual Big Sing, bringing tens of thousands of children together to sing virtually with their idols. Artists featured in the Virtual Big Sing include; Jessie J, the Kingdom Choir, the BeatBox Collective, Matt Henry, Danny Jones, Camilla Kerslake, MNEK, Becky Hill, Gabrielle, Aston Merrygold (JLS), Mark Feehily (Westlife), Claire Sweeney, Nathan Evans, Red, Kirsten Joy, Marisha Wallace, Alexandra Burke and Professor Green.

Mark is the proud founder of Singology choir, the ever-growing London-based community choir established in 2004, who featured as the first ever community choir to sing for the Queen's Christmas speech in 2021.

He is Musical Director of ACM Gospel Choir, who featured as semi-finalists in the BBC's Last Choir Standing 2008. The choir won the Urban Music Award for Best Gospel Act in 2013, and hold the world record for the Highest Ever Carol Concert on a Plane with EasyJet in 2014. They have recorded three studio albums, and regularly perform at a range of public, private and corporate events, bringing a fresh slant to gospel and contemporary staples - recently spotted performing at the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Concert 2022 backing Alicia Keys & Diana Ross.

EDUCATION

Following his time studying at Colchester Institute, Mark went on to train in MA Voice Studies at the Central School of Speech and Drama and subsequently obtained a PGCE in Music Education from the Institute of Education.
